About Big Steps to Success

Big Steps to Success is a mentorship program specifically designed for children and youth living in government care who are between the ages of 7 and 14. This initiative will establish partnerships between child welfare organizations and Big Brothers Big Sisters agencies to offer customized mentoring for these young people. The objective of the program is to help young people living in government care improve educational outcomes and benefit from a caring adult relationship. Each mentee-mentor pair will participate in the program for a period of three to five years, with a minimum commitment of one year.

Purpose of the Position

Working under the direction of the Officer, Grants & Programs, the Graphic Designer (GD), Big Steps to Success will help to create a national brand for the program by developing a set of public facing marketing assets (i.e. logos, promotional materials - flyers/posters, presentation/powerpoint templates, website elements, etc.). The GD will present multiple options for review and work closely with program staff and stakeholders to collect and incorporate feedback before final approval. Guidance and coaching will be provided by the Foundations in-house Graphic Designer.

Responsibilities

- Meet with program staff and stakeholders to determine requirements and vision for design elements, potential for multiple strategy meetings
- Design marketing assets including but not limited to program logos, letterheads, promotional materials, presentation template and website elements
- Create and present multiple versions/options to the team for review and incorporate feedback accordingly
- Review final versions to ensure there are no errors and provide finalized materials in multiple formats



Competencies and Skills

- Strong time management skills and ability to meet tight deadlines
- Ability to work on multiple project items and concepts at once
- Attention to detail and ability to incorporate creative feedback from multiple parties
- Patience with review and approval process and open to making multiple adjustments to items
- Creative and technical skills needed to work with popular graphic design programs (i.e. Adobe Suite)
- Flexible and able to pivot project priorities quickly
- Ability to work independently

- This is a fee for service contract. Project work should be complete by the end of August 2022 at the latest
